In its announcement, EdDPrograms.org noted that because Fordham's part-time online doctorate for K-12 leaders reflects the university's Jesuit principles, it may be an especially attractive pick for educators who are interested in serving students in Catholic schools or in marginalized, urban, and underserved communities.
